Importance

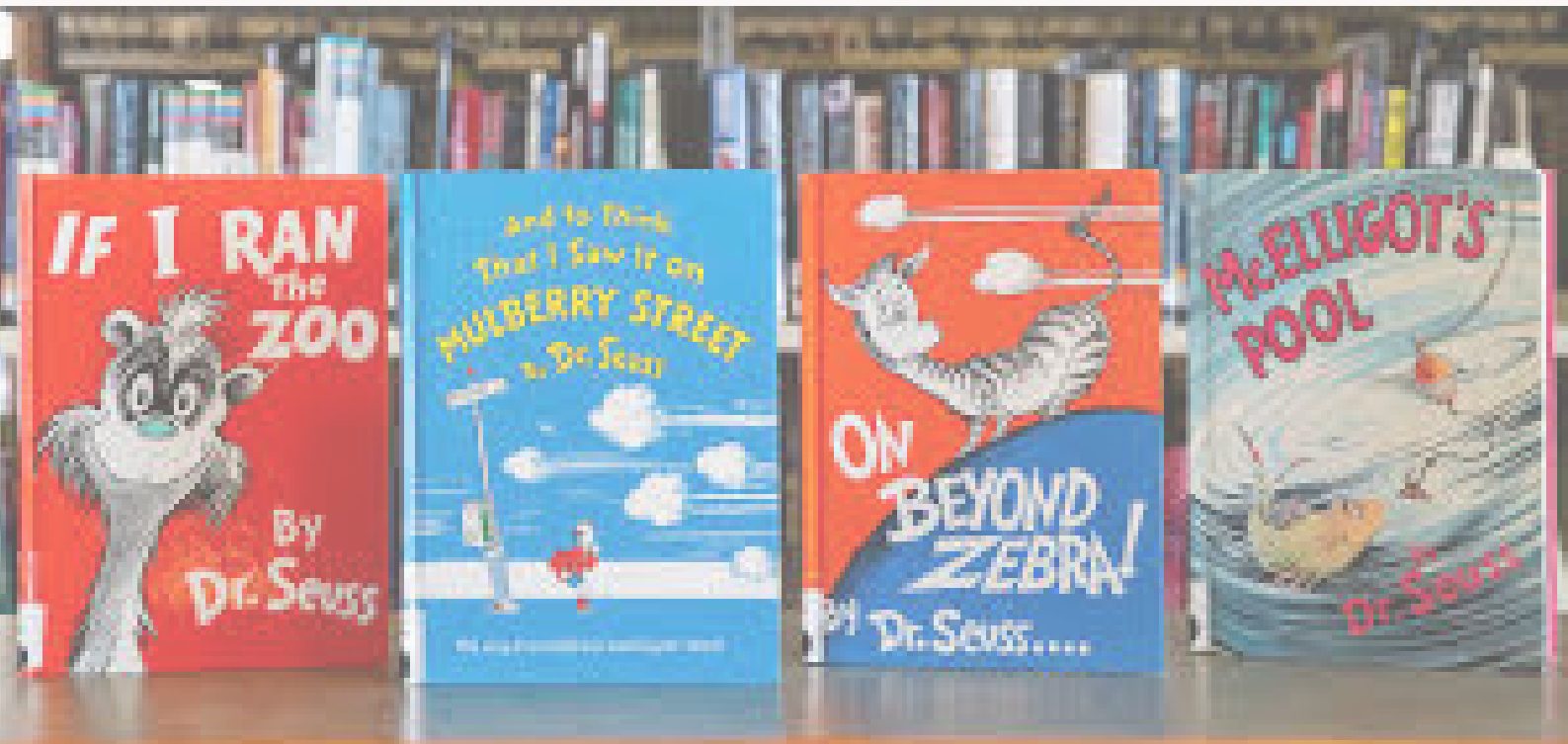

The Fitness Finders Reading Tokens is a great way to make reading even more engaging by rewarding students with tokens or badges when they accomplish certain reading milestones.

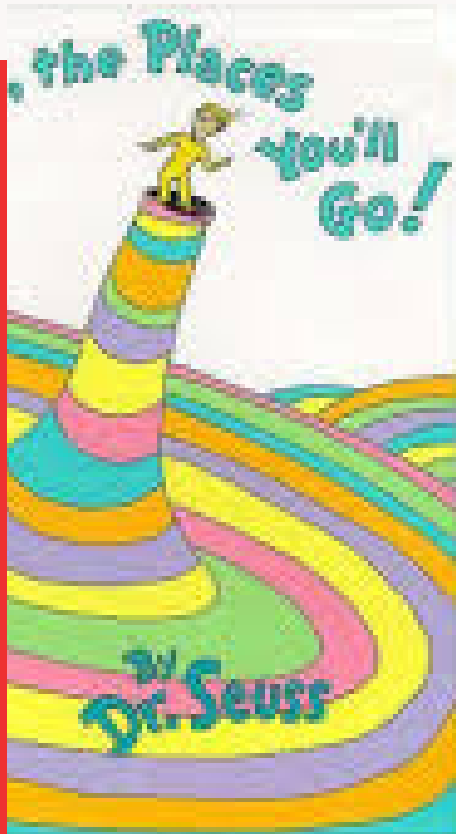
The integration of Fitness Finders Reading Tokens encourages children to explore the world of reading all kinds of different books.

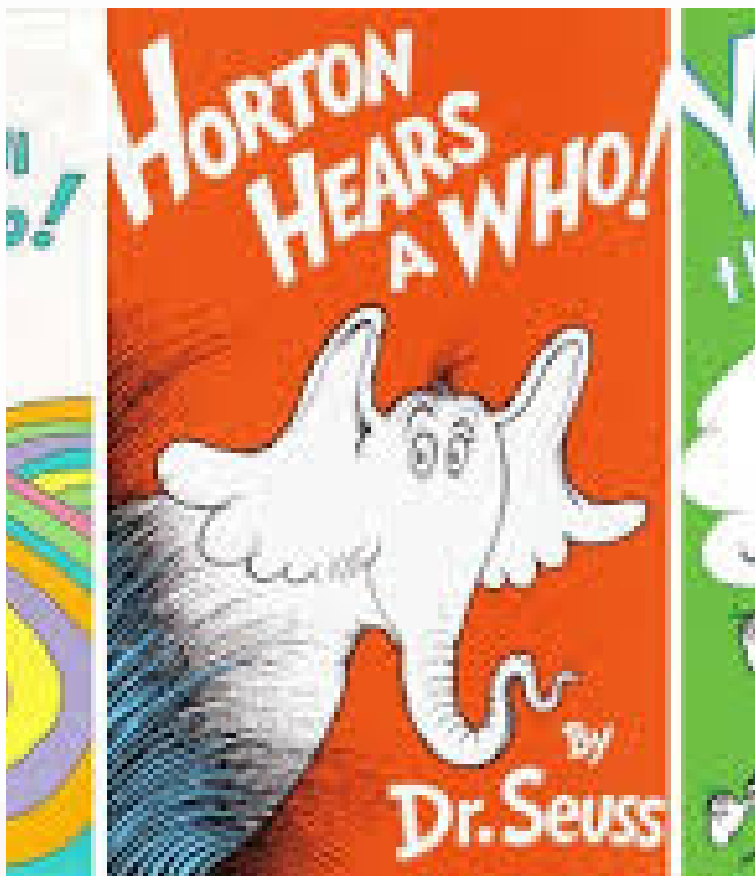
