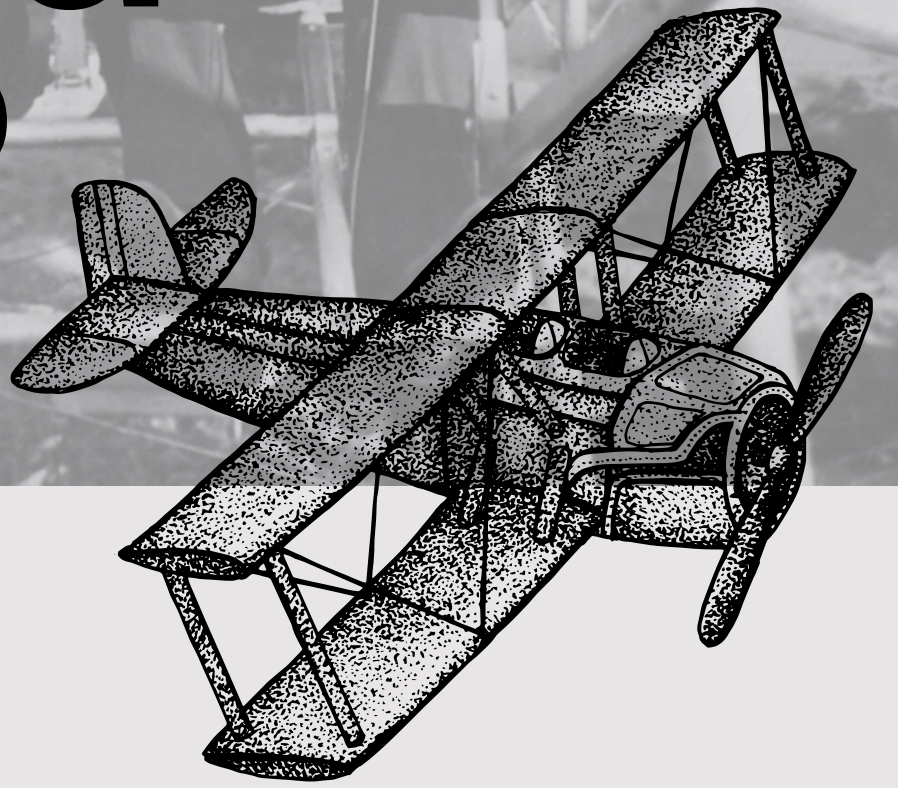

1903

Orville and Wilbur Wright defied gravity for the first time. Flying for 12 seconds in Kitty Hawk, North Carolina

120 feet

The Wright brothers' first powered flight covered just 120 feet. Modern Passenger jets can travel over 500 mph.
